- Year long courses earn 1 credit. Semester long courses earn ½ credit. Marking Period long courses earn ¼ credits.
- Daily courses earn 2 credits per year.
- Note: English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, WL, PLTW and some electives are year-long courses (two semesters). Other electives are semester long or marking period long. If taking marking period long (¼ credit) courses, students must select **2 or 4 total**.
