

Informational Sheet 10th -12th Grade

1. The **Course Selection Worksheet** is used for students and parents to plan out what courses you would like to request online through the **PowerSchool Student Portal App**. (You still have to go online and request your courses. The PowerSchool Student Portal App will be open from January 14, 2022- January 24, 2022. All requests must be entered during this time.)
 - a. Requests must be made online by January 24, 2022.
2. When Requesting Daily Algebra 2:
 - a. Choose **ONLY** Sem: Alg 2
3. **10th Grade Health:**
 - a. Last Names A-L will already be assigned to Semester 1
 - b. Last Names M-Z will already be assigned to Semester 2
4. **10th Grade TE Quarter (MP) classes-**
 - a. Last Names A-L choose Q1 and Q2
 - b. Last Names M-Z choose Q3 and Q4
5. When choosing AP Calculus **AB-**
 - a. Choose **both** AP Calculus AB **AND** Sem: AP Calc AB
6. Teacher recommendations for each of the core subject areas will show up on the screen when requesting courses. These represent where your current teacher feels you will be best placed for the 2022-2023 school year.
7. If a course needs to be repeated due to failure, please select under the repeat tab
8. When selecting electives where there is an indication that you need to audition for the course, please select the course online and you will be notified when auditions will take place.

Questions about course selection can be answered at the Virtual Scheduling Night for the 2022-2023 School Year Q&A, during one-on-one meeting with your child's specific School Counselor during their semester 2 Social Studies class. If your student has not completed the online course selection, they will be required to do so before a meeting with their School Counselor will be scheduled; the student will not meet with their School Counselor until their course selections are complete.
