- Remember, you are building a **YEAR-long** schedule: Students should select 4 credits for the Fall (1<sup>st</sup> semester) and 4 credits for the Spring (2<sup>nd</sup> Semester) to build a full schedule.
- Year long courses earn 1 credit. Semester long courses earn ½ credit. Marking Period long courses earn ¼ credits.
- Daily courses earn 2 credits per year.
- Note: English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, WL, PLTW and some electives are year-long courses (two semesters). Other electives are semester long or marking period long. If taking marking period long courses, students must select **2 or 4 total**.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Seniors are eligible for Early Release if all graduation requirements will be met within the 2023-2024 school year.</li> <li>● Seniors who are requesting Early Release are strongly advised to check with their college admissions office for admissions criteria.</li> <li>● If seniors would like to take electives in addition to the courses above, please make selections on the elective sheet and enter into Student Portal. <b>Only select those courses you want to take. Do NOT list alternates. You will be scheduled for any electives you list in Student Portal.</b></li> <li>● Seniors on Early Release <b>must</b> leave the building after their last scheduled class, no exceptions.</li> <li>● Seniors may NOT loiter on school property or in the school building if they do not have a scheduled class.</li> <li>● Seniors are NOT permitted to have late arrival.</li> <li>● Parents must agree for their senior to have early release.</li> <li>● If a student takes an AACC class for dual credit: <b>It is the student's responsibility to bring their official AACC transcript to the SPHS registrar upon course completion in order for high school credit to be awarded.</b> Students will only receive an "S" or "U" for a final grade.</li> <li>● Students must work with Mrs. McKay (jmckay@aacps.org), Internship Coordinator, in order to earn high school credit for any internship experience.</li> </ul>
