4 Steps to Graduation	
Step 1	Earn a minimum of 26 credits
Step 2	Pass the state-mandated assessments <i>(see High School Program of Study)</i>
Step 3	Complete 75 Hours of Service Learning in grades 5-11
Step 4	Choose one or more Completer Program Pathway* <i>*(see below and the reverse of this sheet for available Pathways)</i>

Career Completer (employment and/or post secondary education after high school)
