- Remember, you are building a **YEAR-long** schedule: Students should select 4 credits for the Fall (1st semester) and 4 credits for the Spring (2nd Semester).
- Yearlong courses earn 1 credit. Semester long courses earn ½ credit. Marking Period long courses earn ¼ credits.
- Note: Algebra 2 with seminar classes meet daily. Daily courses earn 2 credits per year.
- Note: English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, WL, POE and some electives are year-long courses (two semesters). Other electives are semester long or marking period long. If taking marking period long (¼ credit) courses, students must select **2 or 4 total**.
